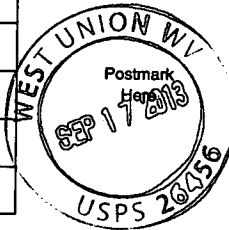

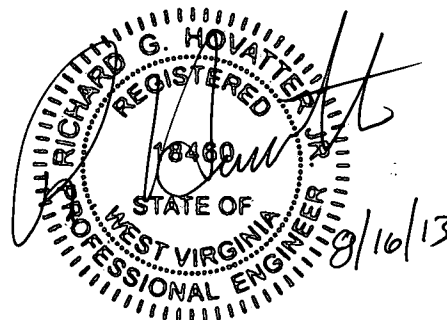

Mr. Wellings:

On behalf of Crestwood Appalachia Pipeline LLC (Crestwood), Thrasher Group, Inc., is submitting to your office for review and approval an application package for a Doddridge County Location Improvement Permit for a proposed compressor station in the USGS Smithburg 7.5 minute quadrangle of Doddridge County, WV. Crestwood plans to construct a compressor station which will be used to provide dehydration, separation, and compression for raw natural gas from producers who have gas wells near this pad. Treatment and compression of the natural gas will be provided so that the gas flows through pipelines in a more efficient manner. Additionally, an associated access road will be constructed, traveling approximately 0.2 miles in length, beginning at Boggs Run Road. This access road will then travel in a westerly direction leading to the compressor station.

The proposed compressor station will be located off Boggs Run Road, approximately 4 air miles from the city of Center Point, in Doddridge County, West Virginia. Approximate center coordinates of the compressor station are 39°21'02.81"N and 80°40'00.77W.

The USGS topographical map and aerial imagery map, contained herein, depict the proposed limits of disturbance associated with proposed construction. In addition, the proposed West Union Compressor Station is located completely outside of the 100 year flood elevation area.



On behalf of Crestwood Appalachia Pipeline LLC (Crestwood), Thrasher Group, Inc. (Thrasher), is submitting to your office for review and approval a response letter regarding the email you had sent Don Drennen of our offices on 07/22/2013.

Per your conversation with Thomas Marion with Thrasher on 07/22/2013, we offer the following information. The work proposed to be done within the floodplain at the intersection of Boggs Run Road and Big Flint Road in Doddridge County, WV will not adversely impact the floodplain. This work will consist of the widening of the existing road, Boggs Run, and will not raise any elevation within the existing floodplain.

This widening will be achieved by first removing the existing gravel on the road to create a suitable base on which to construct a more stable roadway. The contractor shall then excavate the hill on the eastern side of Boggs Run Road in order to widen the travel lane of the road from approximately nine (9) feet in width to approximately fifteen (15) in width. This proposed cut slope has been investigated by a third-party geotechnical engineering firm and based upon their findings no slopes shall exceed 1:1 slope in steepness. Once the travel lane has been widened, the roadway shall be re-graveled to the elevation of the existing road surface.



The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has reviewed the report on the bat **mist net** survey conducted in the proposed project area and submitted on 9 Aug 2013. The survey followed the protocol outlined in the Draft Indiana Bat Recovery Plan. The survey covered 34 acres/kilometers of potential bat habitat and was conducted at 4 net sites from July 12 to July 31. No federally listed bats were captured.

Surveys are considered current for 5 years (the summer they are completed and the following four summer seasons). In this case, the survey will expire on May 15, 2018. If a significant amendment is proposed to change or expand this project, or if timber will be removed after that date, a new survey may be necessary and the Service should be contacted.

The area was surveyed for caves and abandoned mine portals and none were found in the action area.

Based on the information provided to us, the Service has concluded that no federally listed endangered and threatened bats are expected to be impacted by the project. Therefore, no biological assessment or further section 7 consultation under the Endangered Species Act (ESA) (87 Stat. 884, as amended; 16 U.S.C. 1531 *et seq.*) is required with the Service. Should project plans change or amendments be proposed that we have not considered in your proposed action, or if additional information on listed and proposed species becomes available, or if new species become listed or critical habitat is designated, this determination may be reconsidered. 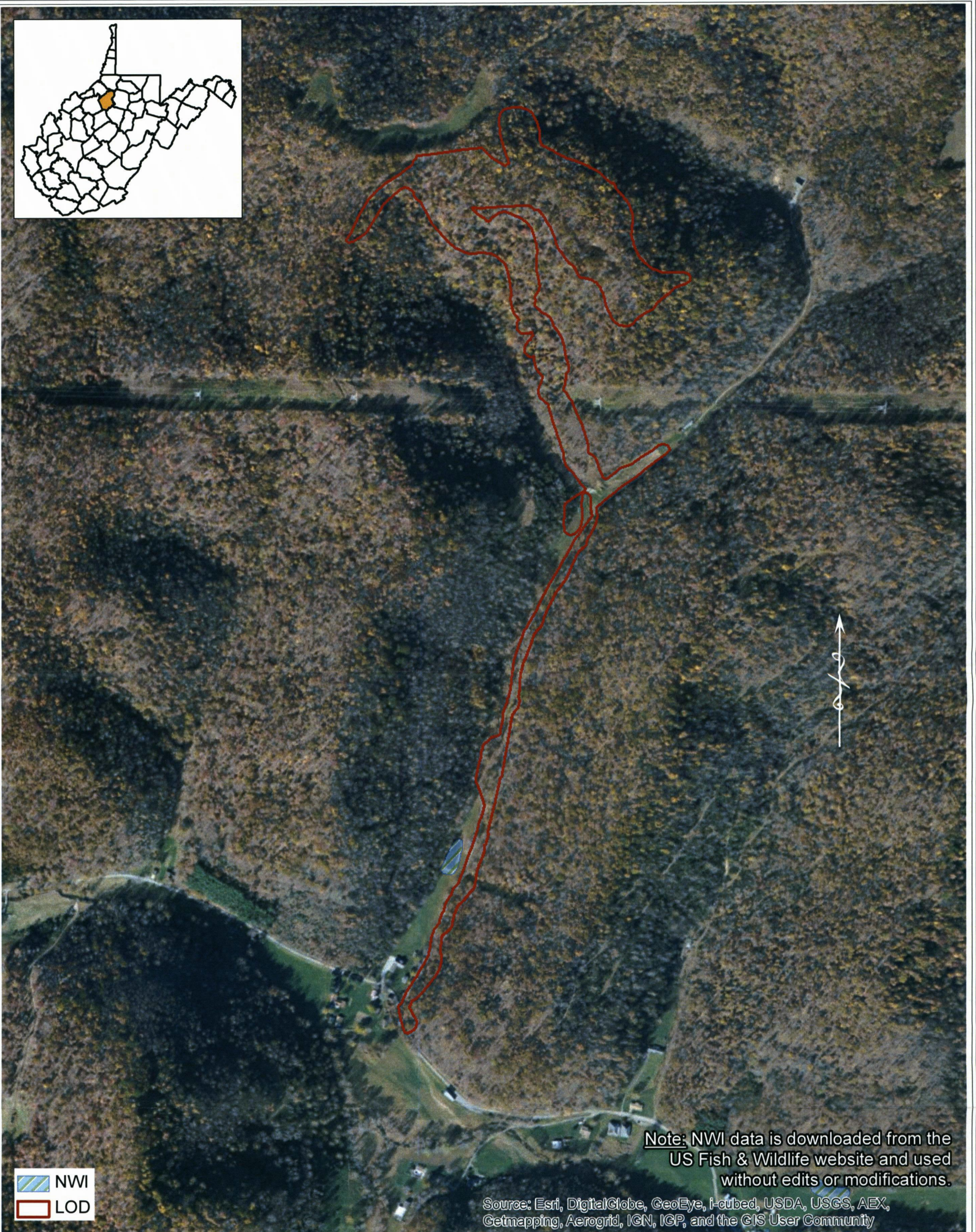

I refer to the Pre-Construction Notification (PCN) received in this office on June 25, 2013, with PCN revisions received in the office on July 26 and August 27, 2013, requesting authorization to discharge dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States in conjunction with the Crestwood Appalachia Pipeline LLC Victoria Compressor Station. The proposed work is located in an unnamed tributary to Boggs Run. Boggs Run is a tributary of Flint Run of Middle Island Creek, a traditional navigable water (TNW) of the United States. The proposed project is located off of Boggs Run Road, approximately four air miles from the City of Center Point, in Doddridge County, West Virginia (39.34909 °N, 80.66557 °W). The PCN has been assigned the following file number: LRH-2013-00637-OHR-UNT to Boggs Run. Please reference this number on all future correspondence related to this project.

The United States Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) authority to regulate waters of the United States is based on the definitions and limits of jurisdiction contained in 33 CFR 328 and 33 CFR 329. Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (Section 404) requires a Department of the Army (DA) permit be obtained prior to discharging dredged or fill material into waters of the United States, including wetlands. Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (Section 10) requires a DA permit be obtained for any work in, on, over or under a navigable water.

Based on a review of the aquatic resources in the PCN, one (1) stream (UNT 7) is located within the proposed project area, as described in Table 1 below. The on-site aquatic resources may be waters of the United States in accordance with the Regulatory Guidance Letter for Jurisdictional Determinations (JDs) issued by the Corps on June 26, 2008 (Regulatory Guidance Letter No. 08-02). As indicated in the guidance, this Preliminary Jurisdictional Determination (PJD) is non-binding and cannot be appealed (33 CFR 331.2) and only provides a written indication that waters of the United States may be present on-site.

You have declined to exercise the option to obtain an approved JD in this instance and at this time. However, for the purposes of the determination of impacts, compensatory mitigation, and other resource protection measures for activities that require authorization from this office, the stream referenced above will be evaluated as if it is waters of the United States.

The proposed project, as described in the submitted information, has been reviewed in accordance with Section 404 and Section 10. Based on your description of the proposed work, and other information available to us, it has been determined that this project will not involve activities subject to the requirements of Section 10. However, this project will include the discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States subject to the requirements of Section 404.

In the PCN received in this office on June 25, 2013, with PCN revisions received in the office on July 26 and August 27, 2013, you have requested authorization to discharge dredged and/or fill material into 188.57 linear feet of one ephemeral stream channel for the construction of an access road. The proposed discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States is described in enclosed Table 1.

Based on your description of the proposed work, it has been determined the proposed discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States, as described on Table 1 enclosed with this letter, for the construction of the linear transportation project associated with the Victoria Compressor Station Project meets the criteria for authorization under Nationwide Permit (NWP) #14 (attached) under the February 21, 2012 Federal Register, Notice of Reissuance of NWPs (77 FR 10184) provided you comply with all terms and conditions of the enclosed material. In view of the above, your linear transportation project is authorized subject to the terms and conditions of the enclosed material, including the attached special conditions. It is your responsibility to ensure that your work conforms to all of the environmental management conditions listed within the enclosed material. Please be aware this NWP verification does not obviate the requirement to obtain any state or local assent required by law for the activities.

This verification is valid until the expiration date of the NWPs, unless the NWP authorization is modified, suspended, or revoked. The verification will remain valid if the NWP authorization is reissued without modification or the activity complies with any subsequent modification of the NWP authorization. Prior to this date, it is not necessary to contact this office for re-verification of your project unless the plans for the proposed activity are modified. Furthermore, if you commence or under contract to commence this activity before March 18, 2017, you will have twelve (12) months from the date of the modification or revocation of the NWP to complete the activity under the present terms and conditions of this NWP.

A copy of this NWP and verification letter must be supplied to your project engineer responsible for construction activities. A copy of the verification letter must be kept at the site during construction. Upon completion of the work, the enclosed certification must be signed and returned to this office.
