On behalf of Crestwood Marcellus Midstream LLC (Crestwood), The Thrasher Group Inc., is submitting to your office for review and approval an application package for a Doddridge County Location Improvement Permit for a proposed project in the USGS New Milton 7.5 minute quadrangle of Doddridge County, WV. The proposed area of interest (AOI) for the Plaugher North pipeline consists of a 75' construction right-of-way (ROW) and contains approximately 8.75 acres. The proposed 12" steel Plaugher North pipeline originates at approximately 39.27056 N, 80.608340 W located at the Plaugher well pad. From there the pipeline extends 5,040.27 LF northwest to the Leonard gathering line located at approximately 39.264749 N, 80.596031 W.

The USGS topographical map and aerial imagery map contained herein depict the proposed limits of disturbance associated with the proposed construction. No aboveground or underground structures are proposed to be constructed within the 100 year flood plain. In addition, after construction, all material will be replaced to restore original elevation, slope and contour. Note that all required federal and state permit applications have been submitted for the project and are attached.





CRESTWOOD proposes to construct a natural gas pipeline that will constist of approximately 5,040 LF of 12" steel gas line along with numerous welds and fittings. This line will transport natural gas from a proposed well head to an exisitng gas transmission line.
This project consists of three (3) unnamed tributary (UNT) crossings in relation to the area of interest (AOI) of the gas line.
All three (3) crossings will occur within the gas line right-of-way. These three (3) crossings are classified as being intermittent. Another ephemeral UNT is near the construction AOI; however disturbance to this resource is not anticipated. The Division of Natural Resources hereby grants to you for a term of 10 years, from the date hereof, a License and Right of Entry to construct, replace, cover, repair, operate, maintain, use and remove a twelve inch (12") steel pipeline along unnamed tributaries of Buffalo Calf Fork, in Doddridge County, West Virginia, as shown located and highlighted in red on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A.

This License and Right of Entry is subject to the following terms and conditions:

**High Quality Streams** (HQS) as listed in the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources High Quality Stream Sixth Edition published in 2001 and for any trout streams and direct tributaries of trout streams:

- Directional boring is the only method permitted during the fish spawning season.
   Fish spawning season for warmwater streams runs from April 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup>.
   Trout spawning season runs from October 1<sup>st</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Other dry ditch methods (pump around, flume or cofferdam) as described in WVDEP water resources manual (published 2006) on page 3.21-4 may be used outside of spawning seasons.
- Each crossing that utilizes dry ditch methods must be completed in 2 consecutive work days.

#### Non-high quality stream:

- Directional boring or other dry ditch methods (pump around, flume or cofferdam) as described in WVDEP water resources manual (published 2006) on page 3.21-4 may be used at all times during fish spawning season from April 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>st</sup>. This eliminates the need for spawning season restrictions.
- Crossings using methods other than directional boring. Must be completed in 1 work day.
- Only ephemeral/intermittent streams that are dry can be trenched.



The proposed Plaugher West pipeline area of interest (AOI) consists of a 75' construction right-of-way (ROW) and contains approximately 8.75 acres. The proposed 12" steel Plaugher North pipeline originates at approximately 39.27056 N, 80.608340 W located at the Plaugher well pad. From there the pipeline extends 5,040.27 LF northwest to the Leonard gathering line located at approximately 39.264749 N, 80.596031 W.

Of the 8.75 acres contained within the AOI, 6.43 acres are forested and timbering activities are expected to occur. As timber removal shall not exceed 17 acres, no adverse impacts to Indiana bat populations are anticipated.

All streams within the proposed AOI have been identified and delineated by Thrasher staff. Three (3) intermittent unnamed tributaries (UNT) were found to cross a portion of the proposed Plaugher North pipeline AOI. Another ephemeral UNT is near the construction AOI; however disturbance to this resource is not anticipated. The attached delineation mapping depicts all findings within the proposed AOI.

We have reviewed the above mentioned project to determine its effects to cultural resources. As required by Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, and its implementing regulations, 36 CFR 800: "Protection of Historic Properties," we submit our comments.

Based on the information submitted, Crestwood Marcellus Midstream, LLC proposes the construction of approximately 5,040 linear feet of pipeline on landforms above Buffalo Calf Fork in Doddridge County, WV. It is our understanding that no above ground project components are proposed as part of this project. Our records indicate no known archaeological resources are located within the proposed project area. In addition, available information, including the results of nearby surveys, indicates the proposed project is primarily located on steep terrain that is unlikely to contain significant archaeological resources. As a result, in our opinion there are no historic properties within the proposed project's APE. No further consultation is necessary. However, if intact cultural resources are encountered, including cemeteries, while constructing the pipeline, please cease all activity in the area of discovery and contact this office immediately.
