Dominion Transmission, Inc. (Dominion) is submitting the enclosed Doddridge County Floodplain Development Permit Application for the H-13680 emergency pipeline replacement project (Project) in Doddridge County, West Virginia.

The Project includes the replacement of approximately 160 linear feet (LF) of 6-inch diameter plastic pipe within the existing right-of-way. Flood Insurance Rate Map information (FIRM Panel #54017C0225C) obtained from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) shows that the project area is located outside of FEMA Flood Zones subject to a one percent annual chance flood event (100-year flood or Base Flood).

Construction activities will include the installation of the underground pipeline using open ditch techniques, waterbars for surface water control, trench plugs for open trench water control, and trench breakers for subsurface water control following pipeline installation. Following installation of the pipeline, the trench will be backfilled and compacted to approximate original contours and the area will be returned to original surface conditions with no permanent above ground structures.

The proposed pipeline will cross one small stream (Sheep Run). If flow is present at the time of construction, the pump around or flume pipe methods will be used to divert water around construction activities. The stream will be restored to pre-construction stream channel dimensions and the banks will be stabilized prior to removal of the water diversion measures. If flow is not present at the time of construction, the crossing will be constructed and the stream restored within 24 hours.

To perform the above work in accordance with State and Federal requirements, Dominion prepared the required Department of the Army (DA) permit application for submission to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Huntington, WV District. The USACE approved the project activities and determined that they meet the requirements of a Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 12 (see enclosed USACE permit approval). A project location map, area map, and the floodplain map (FIRMette) are also enclosed with the permit application.







Dear Mr. Scarpinato:

I refer to the Department of the Army (DA) permit application received in this office on September 9, 2013, requesting authorization to discharge temporary and permanent fill material into nine ephemeral streams, seven intermittent streams, and two emergent wetlands that are indirect tributaries of the Ohio River with the proposed Salem Operating District 2013 Gathering Line Replacement Project. You have also requested a preliminary jurisdictional determination (PJD) for the portions of the site characterized by potential waters of the United States. The project site is located in Doddridge and Tyler Counties, West Virginia at the locations specified in the attached table. The project has been assigned the following file number: LRH-2013-856-OHR-Big Isaac Creek. Please reference this number on all future correspondence related to this project.

The United States Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) authority to regulate waters of the United States is based on the definitions and limits of jurisdiction contained in 33 CFR 328 and 33 CFR 329. Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (Section 404) requires a DA permit be obtained prior to discharging dredged or fill material into waters of the United States, including wetlands. Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (Section 10) requires a DA permit be obtained for any work in, on, over or under a navigable water.

Based on a review of the aquatic resources in the permit application, sixteen channels totaling approximately 390 linear feet (lf) and two wetlands totaling 0.09 acre are located within the proposed project site, and are indirect tributaries to the Ohio River, a traditional navigable water (TNW) of the United States. The channels and wetlands identified above and in the attached Table 1 may be waters of the United States in accordance with the Regulatory Guidance Letter for Jurisdictional Determinations (JDs) issued by the Corps on June 26, 2008 (Regulatory Guidance Letter No. 08-02). As indicated in the guidance, this PJD is non-binding and cannot be appealed (33 C.F.R. 331.2) and only provides a written indication that waters of the United States may be present on-site.

You have declined to exercise the option to obtain an approved JD in this instance and at this time. However, for the purposes of the determination of impacts, compensatory mitigation, and other resource protection measures for activities that require authorization from this office

the streams and wetlands referenced in Table 1, will be evaluated as if they are waters of the United States.

Attached please find two (2) copies of the PJD. If you agree with the findings of this PJD and understand your options regarding the same, please sign and date one copy of the form and return it to this office within 30 days of receipt of this letter. The proposed project, as described in the submitted DA permit application, has been reviewed in accordance with Section 404 and Section 10. Based on your description of the proposed work, and other information available to us, it has been determined that this project will not involve activities subject to the requirements of Section 10. However, this project will include the discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States subject to the requirements of Section 404.

In the DA permit application received in this office on September 9, 2013, you have requested authorization for the discharges of temporary fill material below the ordinary high water mark of 350 lf of fourteen channels and 0.09 acre of wetlands and the discharges of permanent fill material below the ordinary high water mark of 40 lf of two channels at the locations specified in Table 1. You have indicated that the channels and wetlands will be restored to pre-project conditions to the maximum extent practicable. The purpose of the overall project is to replace natural gas gathering pipeline and update access roads in the Salem Operating District within Doddridge and Tyler Counties, West Virginia.

Based on your description of the proposed work, and other information available to us it has been determined the proposed discharges of temporary and permanent fill material into waters of the United States in conjunction with the proposed Salem Operating District 2013 Gathering Line Replacement Project meet the criteria for Nationwide Permit Number (NWP) No. 12 (attached) under the February 21, 2012 Federal Register, Notice of Reissuance of Nationwide Permits (77 FR 10184) provided you comply with all terms and conditions of the enclosed material. The NWPs expire on March 18, 2017. A copy of this NWP can be found on our website at http://www.lrh.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory.aspx.

Please be aware this nationwide permit authorization does not obviate the requirement to obtain other Federal, state or local authorizations required by law. A copy of this NWP and verification letter must be supplied to your project engineer responsible for construction activities. A copy of the verification letter must be kept at the site during construction.

Upon completion of the work associated with the Dominion Transmission, Inc. Salem Operating District 2013 Gathering Line Replacement Project, the attached certification must be signed and returned to this office. The Division of Natural Resources hereby grants to you for a term of 10 years, from the date hereof, a License and Right of Entry to construct, replace, cover, repair, operate, maintain, use and remove a six inch (6") plastic pipeline at seven (7) separate locations along an unnamed tributary of Riggins Run, an unnamed tributary of Indian Fork, an unnamed tributary of Cabin Run, unnamed tributaries of Flint Run, Sheep Run, and an unnamed tributary of Sheep Run, McCellan, Greenbrier, Central, Grant, and Southwest Districts, Doddridge County, West Virginia, as shown located and highlighted in red on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A - G.

This License and Right of Entry is subject to the following terms and conditions:

High Quality Streams (HQS) as listed in the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources High Quality Stream Sixth Edition published in 2001 and for any trout streams and direct tributaries of trout streams:

- Directional boring is the only method permitted during the fish spawning season.
 Fish spawning season for warmwater streams runs from April 1st through June 30th.
 Trout spawning season runs from October 1st through April 30th.
- Other dry ditch methods (pump around, flume or cofferdam) as described in WVDEP water resources manual (published 2006) on page 3.21-4 may be used outside of spawning seasons.
- Each crossing that utilizes dry ditch methods must be completed in 2 consecutive work days.

Non-high quality stream:

- Directional boring or other dry ditch methods (pump around, flume or cofferdam) as described in WVDEP water resources manual (published 2006) on page 3.21-4 may be used at all times during fish spawning season from April 1st through June 30th. This eliminates the need for spawning season restrictions.
- Crossings using methods other than directional boring. Must be completed in 1 work day.

Only ephemeral/intermittent streams that are dry can be trenched.

Bank Stabilization

All bank stabilization projects must begin immediately upon completion of utility line crossing and be completed within 24 hours of completion of utility line crossing.

Freshwater Mussels

Mussel surveys on streams with known US Fish and Wildlife listed or candidate endangered species will be required if directional boring is not an option. Contact Janet Clayton of the WVDNR Wildlife Diversity Program for information concerning mussels at 304-637-0245.

Work should be completed in as brief a period as possible and within one year from the date of this letter. In the event you fail or refuse to comply with any of the terms or conditions herein, this License and Right of Entry will be canceled and considered null and void and the Division will reject further applications.
