The proposed Smith Pipeline Project will be located off County Route 26/Long Run Road, approximately 2.12 air miles from the city of Central Station, in Doddridge County, West Virginia. The proposed Smith Pipeline Project consists of two (2) buried 20" steel natural gas pipelines, located within two (2) separate 3'X5' ditches approximately ten (10) feet apart in a 95-foot wide construction right-of-way (ROW). The proposed pipeline project originates at the Nichols Pipeline, located at approximate coordinates 39.30114°N and 80.864855°W. From there, it extends approximately 16,270 LF to the Tamela Compressor Site, located at approximate coordinates 39.327042°N and 80.842215°W.

Dear Ms. Kazimier:

I refer to your request, dated November 9, 2015, to modify the original Nationwide Permit (NWP) 12 verification, for the West End Connector Pipeline (LRH-2015-00466-OHR). In the original NWP 12 verification, dated June 15, 2015, you received a Department of the Army (DA) authorization to discharge dredged and/or fill material into 112.33 linear feet (If) of stream channel and 0.357 acres of wetlands, associated with thirty-five (35) single and complete crossings, in conjunction with the West End Connector Pipeline. The proposed NWP verification modification is located approximately 6.0 miles west of West Union, in Doddridge County, West Virginia (39.327042 °N, 80.842215 °W). On-site waters flow into Middle Island Creek, a direct tributary of the Ohio River, a traditional navigable water of the United States.

The United States Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) authority to regulate waters of the United States is based, in part, on the definitions and limits of jurisdiction contained in 33 CFR 328 and 33 CFR 329. Section 404 of the Clean Water Act requires a DA permit be obtained prior to the discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States, including wetlands. Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 requires a DA permit be obtained for any work in, on, over or under a navigable water.

A preliminary jurisdictional determination (PJD) was issued with the original June 15, 2015 NWP 12 Verification. A review of the information contained within the addendum indicates, the previously issued PJD is being revised to reflect the updated project area for the West End Connector Extension project. Based on a review of the addendum, dated November 9, 2015, and the previously issued PJD, dated June 15, 2015, the revised West End Connector project area contains one hundred eighty-nine (189) stream channels, totaling 71,837 linear feet (lf), four (4) emergent wetlands, totaling 0.54 acres, and one (1) open water, totaling 0.21 acres. Of the 71,837 lf of stream channel, 34,495 lf are classified as perennial stream channel, 10,602 lf are classified as intermittent stream channel, and 26,741 lf are classified as ephemeral stream channel. the enclosed PJD Form for a detailed summary of waters within the West End Connector Pipeline project area.

This office has determined that these waters may be jurisdictional waters of the United States in accordance with the Regulatory Guidance Letter for Jurisdictional Determinations issued by the Corps on June 26, 2008 (RGL No. 08-02). As indicated in the guidance, this PJD is non-binding and cannot be appealed (33 C.F.R. 331.2) and only provides a written indication that waters of the United States, including wetlands, may be present on-site.

You have declined to exercise the option to obtain an approved Jurisdictional Determination in this instance and at this time for the area within the PJD. For the purposes of the determination of impacts, compensatory mitigation, and other resource protection measures for activities that require authorization from this office, the streams and wetlands described in the enclosed PJD Form will be evaluated as if they are waters of the U.S. Attached please find two copies of the PJD. If you agree with the findings of this PJD and understand your options regarding the same, please sign and date one copy of the form and return it to this office within 30 days of receipt of this letter. The proposed project, as described in the submitted information, has been reviewed in accordance with Section 404 and Section 10. Based on your description of the proposed work, and other information available to us, it has been determined that this project will not involve activities subject to the requirements of Section 10. However, this project will include the discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the U.S. subject to the requirements of Section 404.

According to the information provided, you have requested the Corps modify the original NWP 12 verification, to facilitate the tie-in of the Nichols Pipeline to the West End Connector Pipeline. The project will include the discharge of dredged and/or fill material into approximately 50 linear feet (0.005 acre) of stream channel at twelve (12) single and complete crossings, for the construction of the West End Connector Extension. The proposed discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States is described within Table 1 (attached). Upon completion of the project, all temporarily affected waters of the United States will be restored to pre-construction conditions.

Based on your description of the proposed West End Connector Extension Project, and other information available to us, it has been determined the proposed discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States, as described in the enclosed Table, meets the criteria for authorization under Nationwide Permit (NWP) #12 (enclosed) under the February 21, 2012 Federal Register, Notice of Reissuance of NWPs (77 FR 10184) provided you comply with all terms and conditions of the enclosed materials and special conditions. The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection has issued 401 Water Quality Certification for this NWP. A copy of this NWP can be found on our website at: http://www.lrh.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory.aspx.

In view of the above, your utility line activities are permitted subject to the terms and conditions of the enclosed material. It is your responsibility to ensure that your work conforms to all of the conditions listed within the enclosed material, including the attached special conditions. Please be aware this NWP verification does not obviate the requirement to obtain any state or local assent required by law for the activities. A copy of these documents should be supplied to your project engineer responsible for project activities and a copy kept at the site during project work. Upon completion of the work, the enclosed completion certification must be signed and returned to this office.

This verification is valid until the expiration date of the NWPs, unless the NWP authorization is modified, suspended, or revoked. The verification will remain valid if the NWP authorization is reissued without modification or the activity complies with any subsequent modification of the NWP authorization. All of the existing NWPs are scheduled to be modified, reissued, or revoked on March 18, 2017. Prior to this date, it is not necessary to contact this office for reverification of your project unless the plans for the proposed activity are modified. Furthermore, if you commence or under contract to commence this activity before March 18, 2017, you will have twelve (12) months from the date of the modification or revocation of the NWP to complete the activity under the present terms and conditions of this NWP.

We have reviewed the above mentioned project to determine its effects to cultural resources. As required by Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, and its implementing regulations, 36 CFR 800: "Protection of Historic Properties," we submit our comments.

Archaeological Resources:

According to the report, systematic archaeological survey was conducted within the proposed project's Area of Potential Effect (APE), which consists of the project's limits of disturbance. Shovel probe excavation and pedestrian reconnaissance determined that much of the APE is comprised of steep terrain. Shovel probes, when excavated, encountered primarily intact soil horizons. No cultural materials were recovered. As a result, we concur that no historic archaeological properties are present within the proposed APE and that no further archaeological investigations are necessary.

Architectural Resources:

We have reviewed the submitted information and concur that the property located within the view shed of the pipeline is not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. No further consultation is necessary regarding architectural resources; however, if your plans should change, please contact our office.

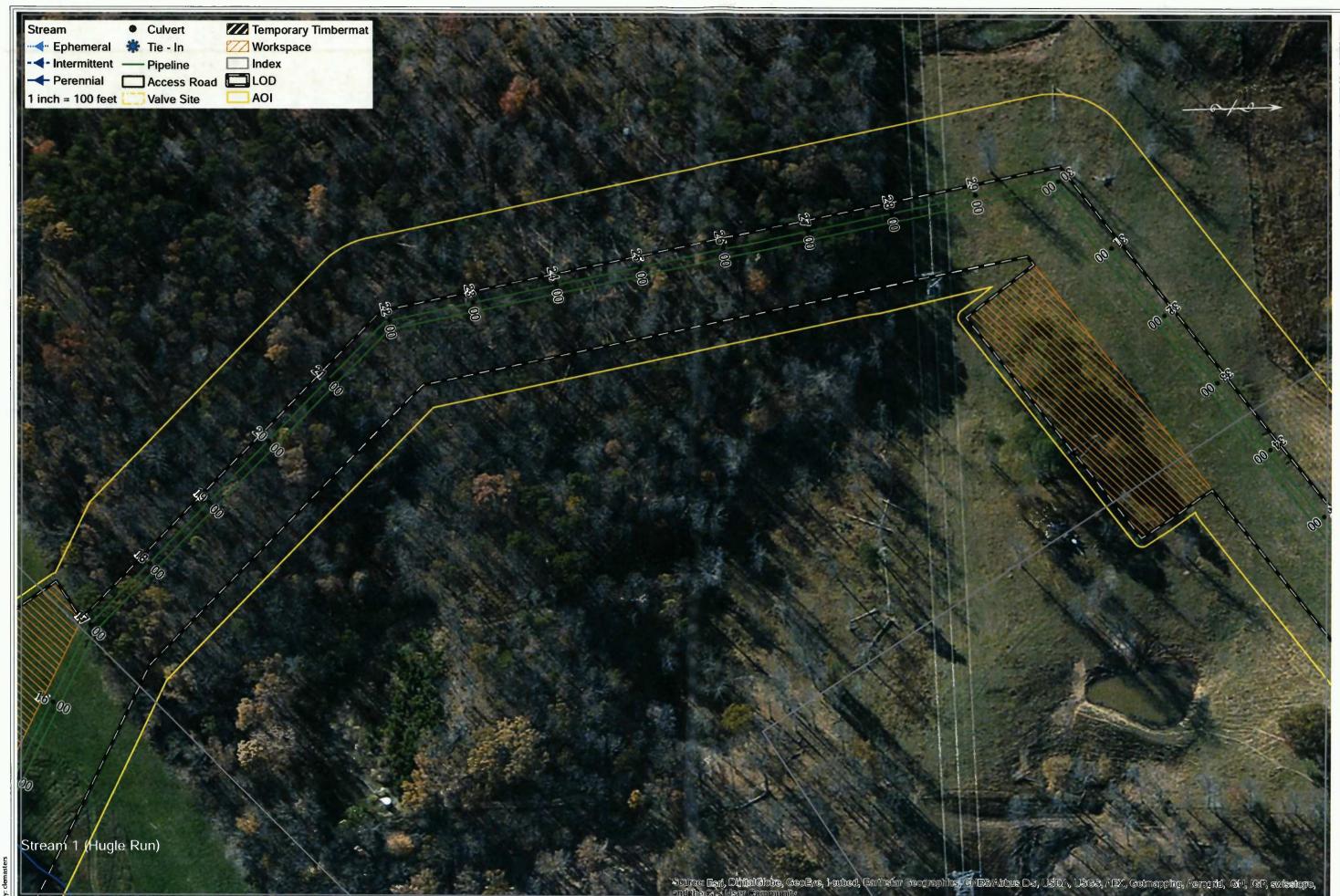
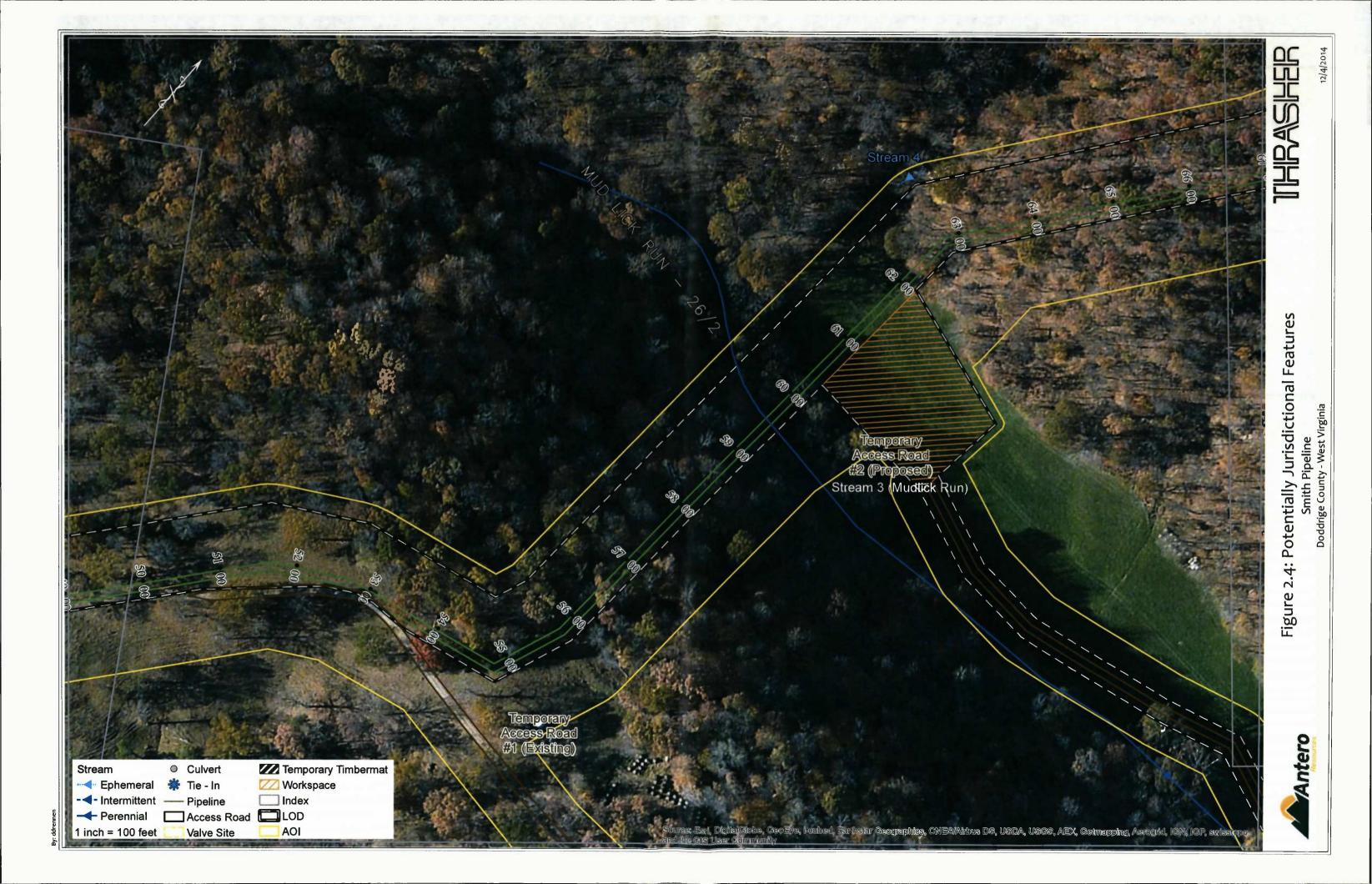






Figure 2.3: Potentially Jurisdictional Features Smith Pipeline Doddrige County - West Virginia









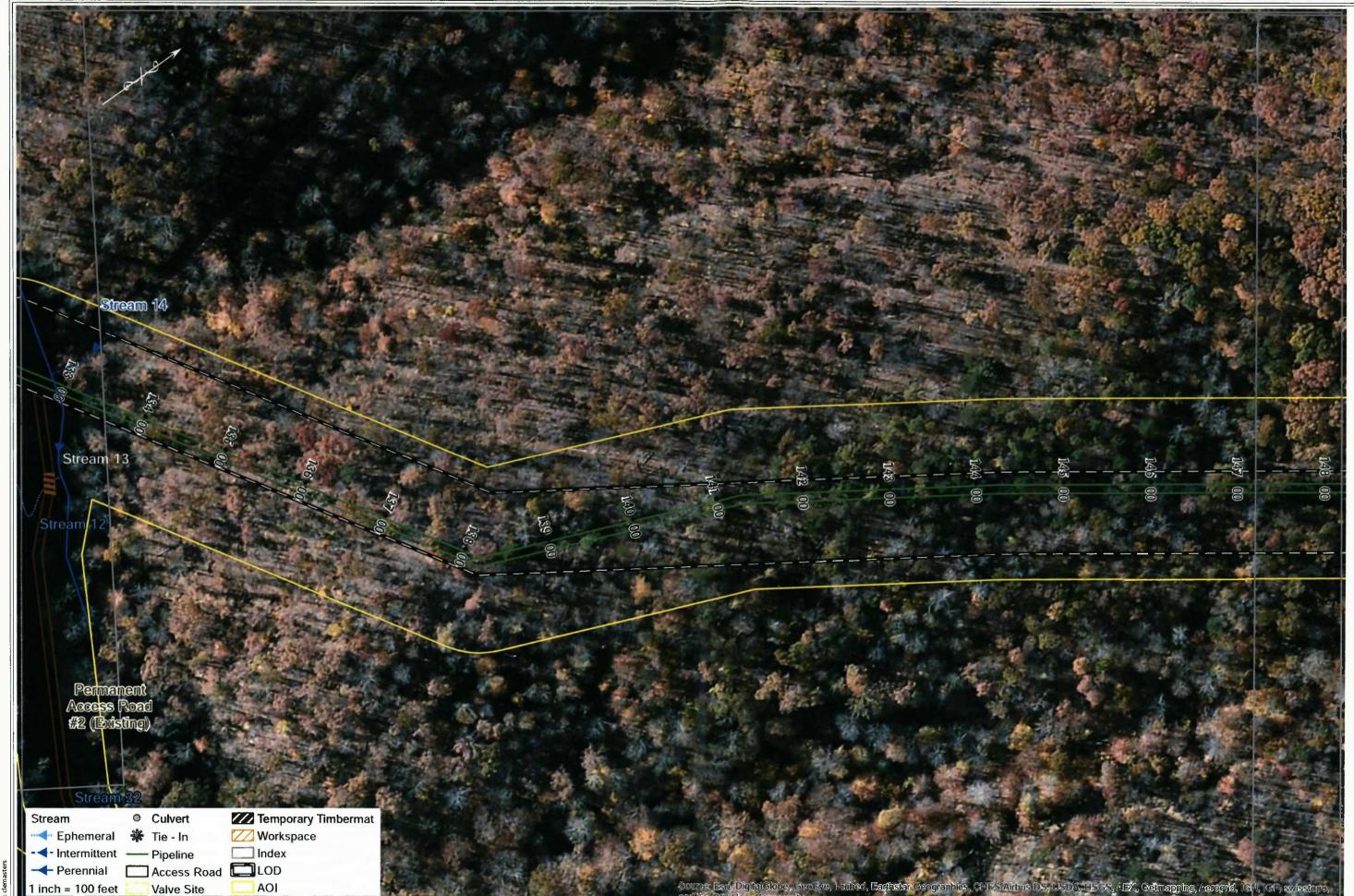














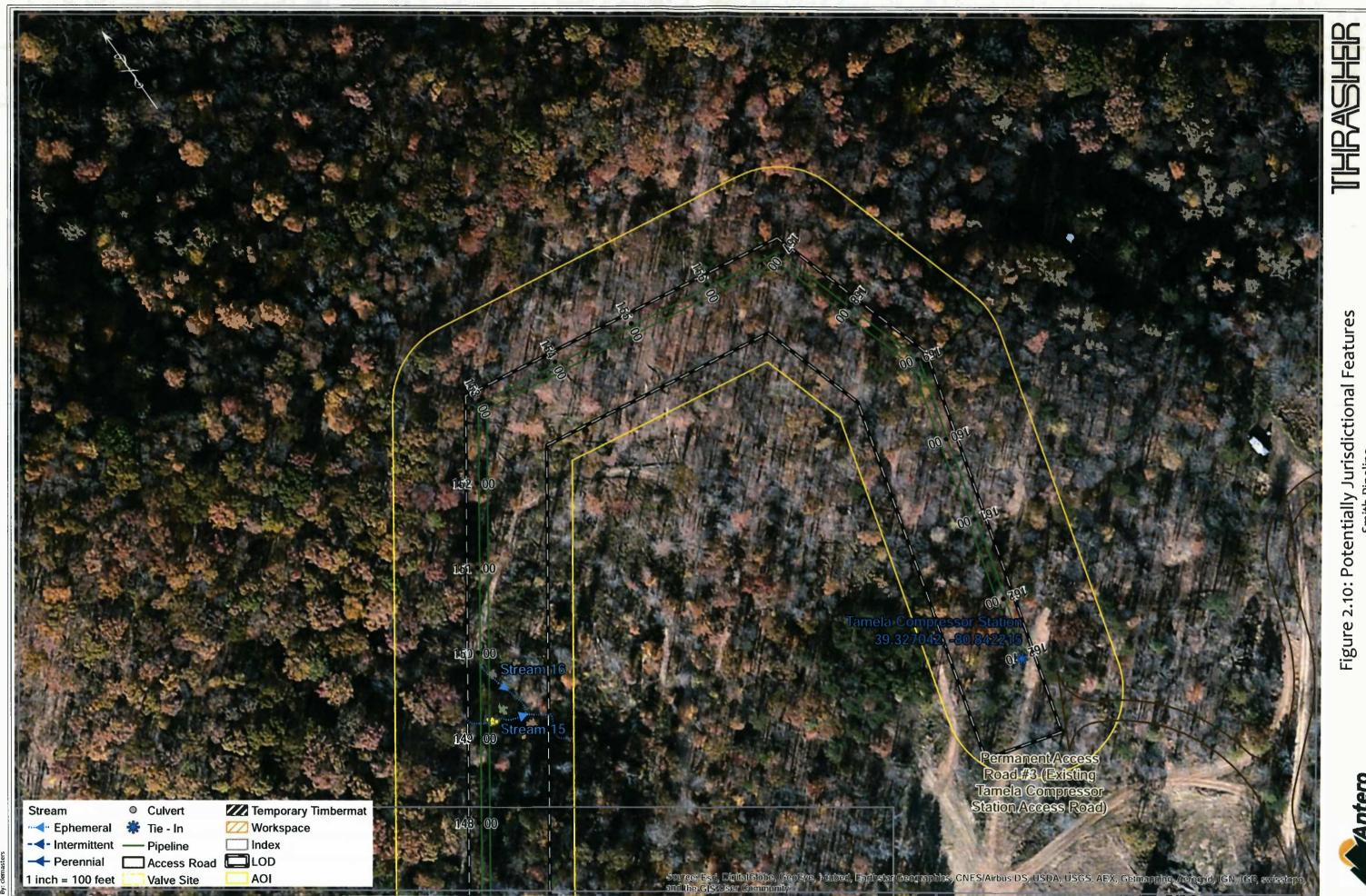
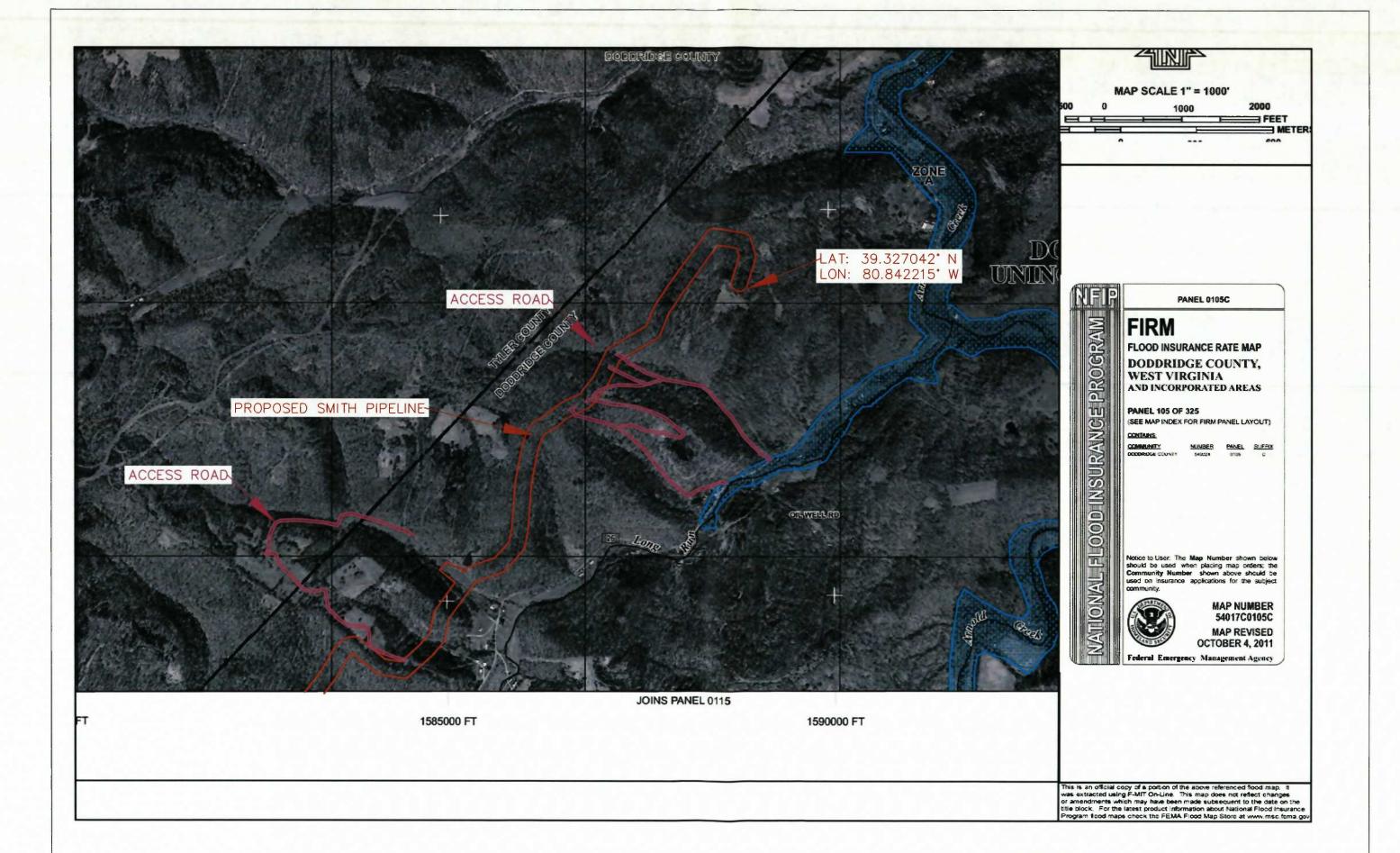
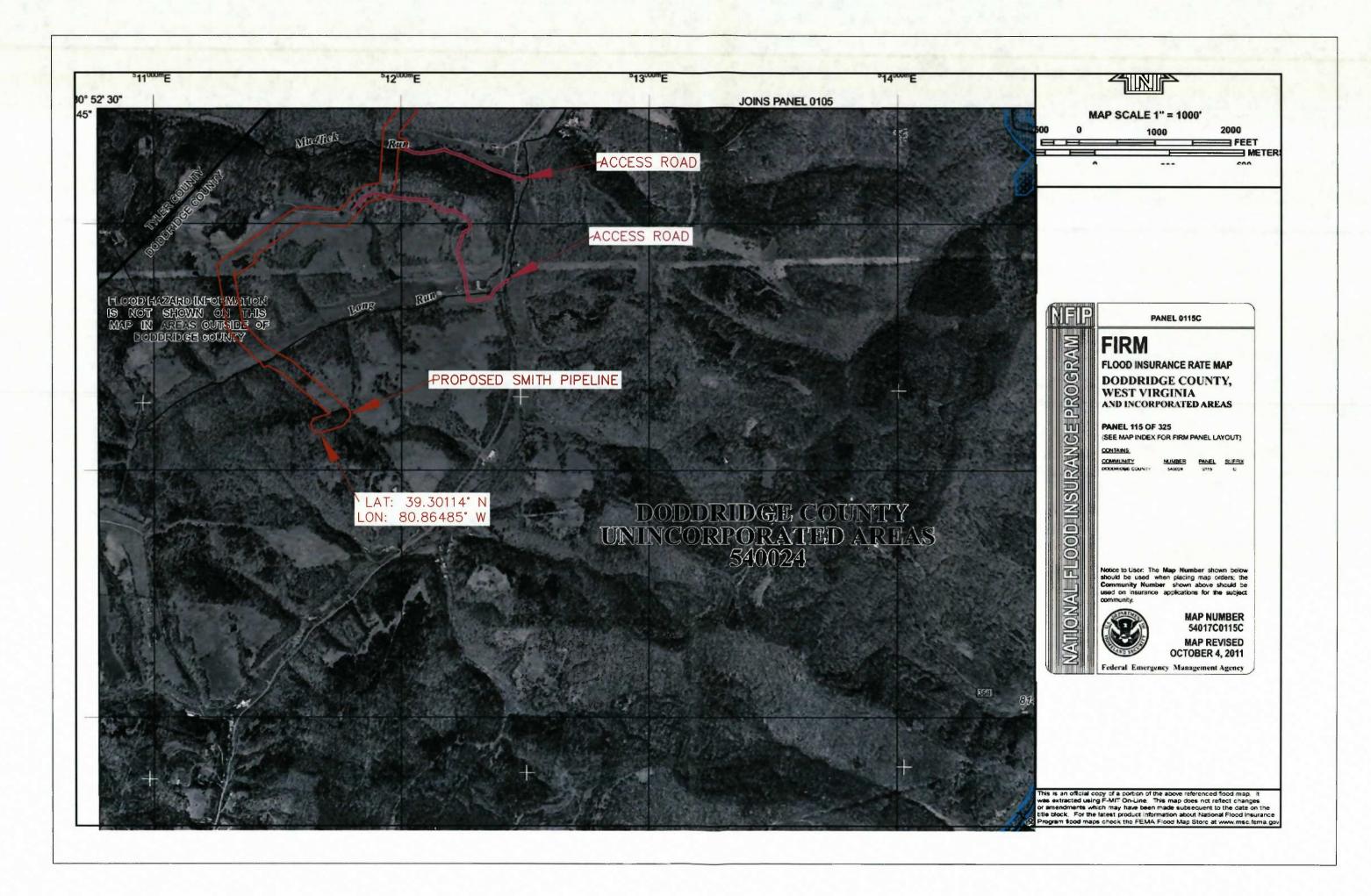
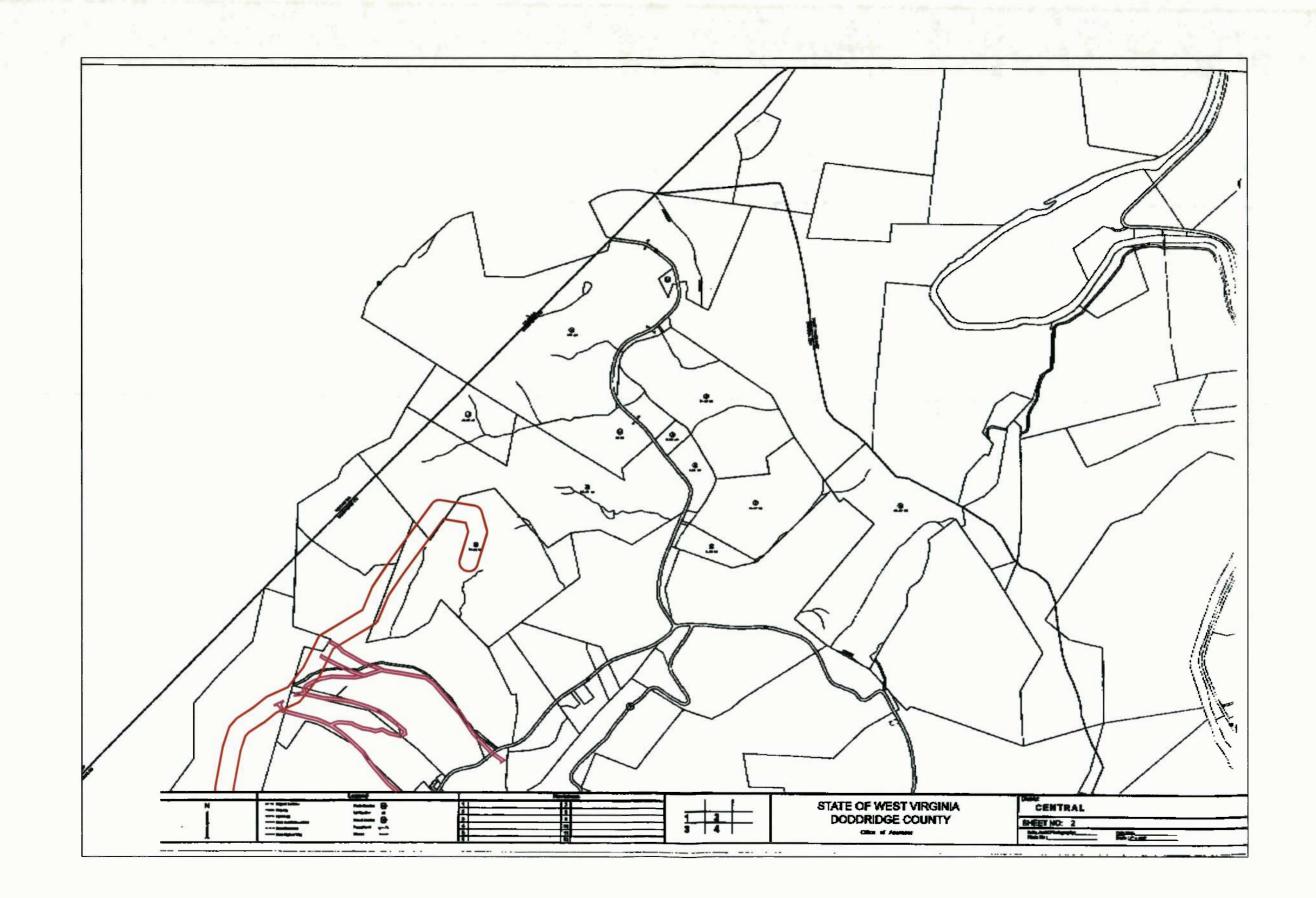


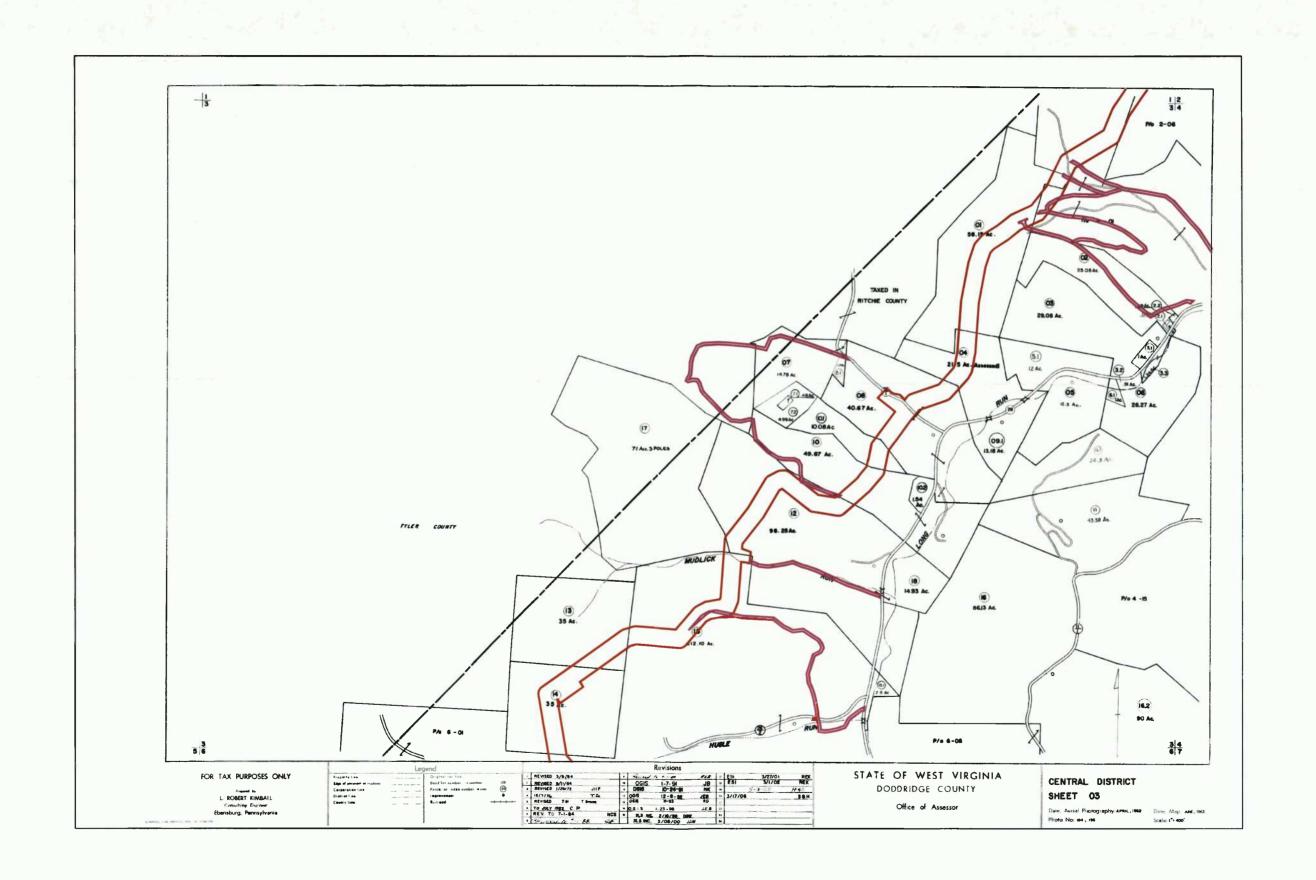


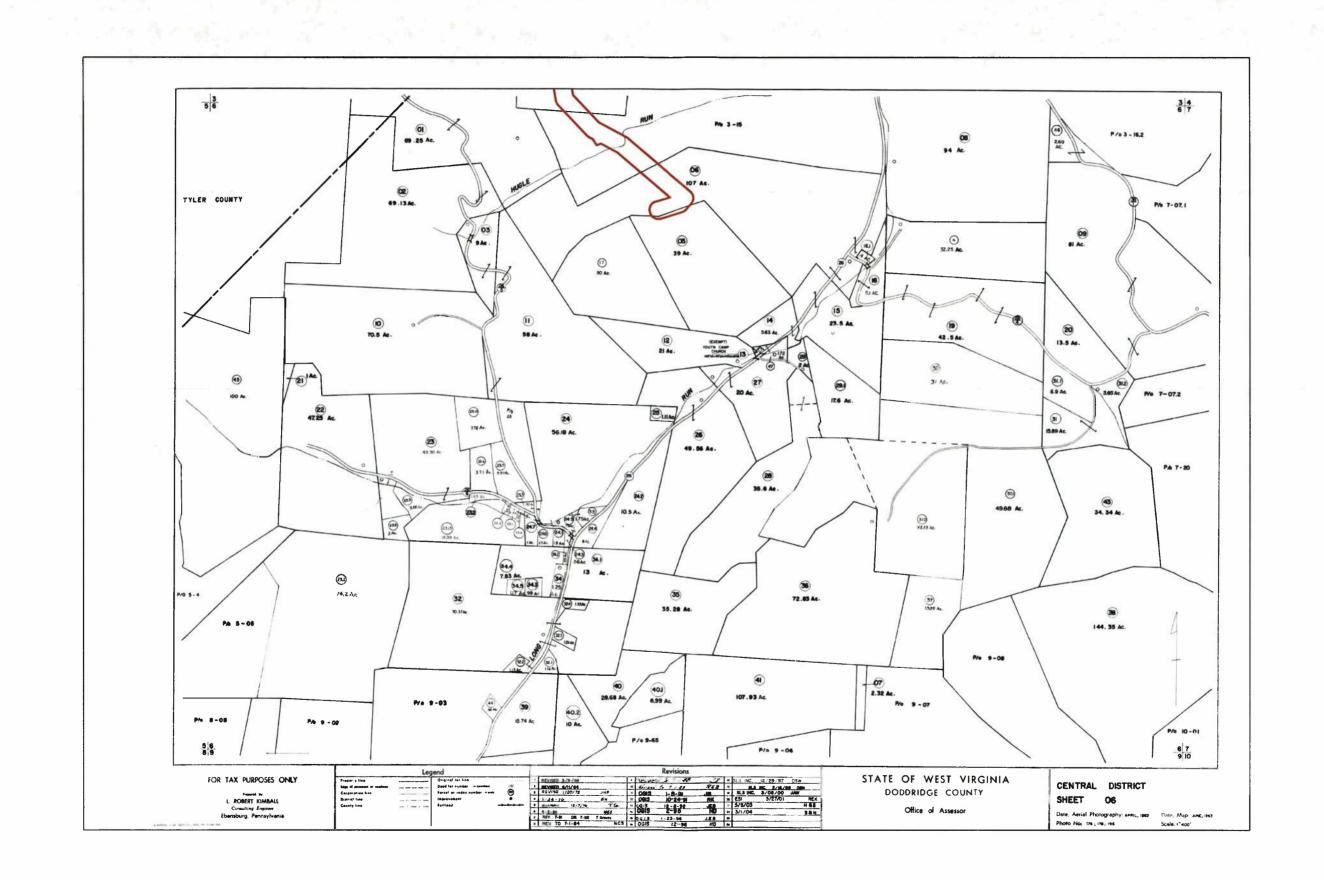
Figure 2.10: Potentially Jurisdictional Features Smith Pipeline
