Site Plan

- 9. Location and dimensions of any roadway development into floodplain/floodway. (Includes initial development access roads)
- 10. Location and dimensions of any bridge and/or culvert development into floodplain/floodway.
- 11. Location and dimensions of any storage yard or facility into the floodplain/floodway.
- Location of any existing utilities and/or proposed utility placement and/or displacement.
- 13. Location, dimensions and depth of any existing or proposed fill on site.
- 14. A survey showing the **existing ground elevations** of at least location on the building site. **ELEVATION NOTE**: All vertical datum will reference either NGVD 29 or NAVD 88. Assumed datum will not be acceptable unless the property is located in an area where vertical datum has not been published. For those areas where vertical datum has not been established, a site plan with contours, elevations using assumed datum, high water marks and existing water levels of sloughs, rivers, lakes or streams and proposed lowest floor elevation.

- I understand that once the floodplain permit is submitted, the application will be entered into
 official public record at the next regularly scheduled Doddridge County Commission meeting
 after the date of submittal.
- I understand that from the date of submittal of the fully completed permit application, the
 Doddridge County Floodplain Manager has ninety (90) days to make a determination to either
 grant or deny said permit application. During this approval period, the Doddridge County
 Floodplain Manager may, at his or her discretion, conduct a review and/or additional study of
 provided documentation by means of an independent engineering firm. All costs associated with
 said review and/or study must be reimbursed to the County before issuance of approved permit.
- I understand that during the approval period, the Doddridge County Floodplain Manager of
 designee may at his or her discretion conduct site visits and document conditions of proposed
 development pursuant to the permit application.
- I understand that once the Floodplain Permit is granted, the permit will be entered into official public record. Appeals to the permit may be made no later than twenty (20) days after said issuance. If a valid appeal is submitted, as determined by the Doddridge County Floodplain Manager, a "Stop Work" order will be issued for all project development directly involving the floodplain or floodway. A public hearing by the Doddridge County Appeals Board will be scheduled no less than ten (10) days after the next regularly scheduled Doddridge County Commission meeting.
- I understand that all decisions of the Doddridge County Appeals Board shall be final.
- I understand issuance of a Floodplain Permit authorizes me to proceed with construction as proposed.
- In signing this application, the primary developer hereby grants the Doddridge County Floodplain
 Manager or designee the right to enter onto the above---described location to inspect the
 development work proposed, in progress, and/or completed.
- I understand that if I do not follow exactly the site—plan submitted and approved by this permit
 that a "Stop Work" order may be issued by the Doddridge County Floodplain Manager and that
 I must stop all construction immediately until discrepancies of actual work vs. proposed work is
 resolved.





I refer to the pre-construction notification (PCN) requesting a Department of the Army (DA) authorization for the discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States (U.S.) in association with the Supply Header Pipeline Restoration Project (Restoration Project). The Supply Header Pipeline Project activities located within the Huntington District were to consist of approximately 33.0-miles of the proposed pipeline, approximately 28.3-miles of proposed access roads, including four valve sites, one pig launcher, one metering and regulation site, and one compressor station upgrade in Doddridge, Tyler and Wetzel Counties, West Virginia. Those activities requiring discharges of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States were verified under Nationwide Permit 12 by the Huntington District on February 14, 2018. The Restoration Project would involve the restoration of Project work areas and completion of select improvements at the three compressor stations. The restoration of some work areas propose discharges of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the United States. The Restoration project has been assigned the following file number: LRH-2014-01110-OHR. Please reference this number on all future correspondence related to this proposed project.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' (Corps) authority to regulate waters of the U.S. is based on the definitions and limits of jurisdiction contained in 33 CFR 328 and 33 CFR 329. Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (Section 404) requires a DA permit be obtained prior to discharging dredged and/or fill material into waters of the U.S., including wetlands. Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (Section 10) requires a DA permit be obtained for any work in, on, over or under a navigable water.

The proposed project, as described in the submitted information, has been reviewed in accordance with Section 404 and Section 10. Based on your description of the proposed work, and other information available to us, it has been determined that this project will not involve activities subject to the requirements of Section 10. However, this project will include the discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the U.S. subject to the requirements of Section 404.

In the submitted PCN materials, you have requested a DA authorization for the temporary discharge of dredged and/or fill material into 0.046 acre of 29 streams and 0.49 acre of seven (7) wetlands at 26 single and complete locations in association with the Restoration Project. The discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the U.S. is described in the enclosed Tables 1 and would consist of the removal of gabion baskets, mats, culvert, stone, pipe bridges, jersey barriers, and associated restoration activities. All work will be conducted in accordance with the PCN received in this office on November 10, 2021.

Based on the provided information, it has been determined the proposed project meets the criteria for Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 12 (enclosed) under the January 13, 2021 Federal Register, Reissuance and Modification of NWPs (86 FR 2744) provided you comply with all terms and conditions of the enclosed material, the enclosed special conditions, and the Section 401 Water Quality Certifications (401 WQC) issued by the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection. A copy of this NWP can be found on our website at http://www.lrh.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory.aspx.

Please be aware this NWP verification does not obviate the requirement to obtain other local, state, and/or federal authorizations required by law for these activities. This verification is valid until the expiration date of the NWPs, unless the NWP authorization is modified, suspended, or revoked. The verification will remain valid if the NWP authorization is reissued without modification or the activity complies with any subsequent modification of the NWP authorization. The NWP 12 is scheduled to be modified, reissued, or revoked on March 14, 2026. Prior to this date, it is not necessary to contact this office for re-verification of your project unless the plans for the proposed activity are modified. Furthermore, if you commence or under contract to commence this activity before March 14, 2026, you will have 12 months from the date of the modification or revocation of the NWP to complete the activity under the present terms and conditions of this NWP.






